- A blood test for antibody to the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) is required as a part of your medical examination. HIV is the virus that causes the acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS). AIDS is the name given to a group of illnesses that may occur in persons infected with HIV. Infection with HIV causes a defect in a person's natural immunity against disease. The defect leaves infected people vulnerable to serious illnesses that would not usually be a threat to anyone whose immune system was intact. This test is not to diagnose AIDS but to detect antibodies to the virus.

-The result of your test will be provided to Australian Health Authority. Also, it may be necessary to report results to the health authorities of Pakistan.

- A positive test result could also have other local consequences on your day-to-day activities in this country.

- A negative test would not warrant any further investigation or counseling. In case of a positive result the doctor would meet you in person for further advice. In case of any query please not hesitate to ask for assistance from staff or doctor.
